House Bill 2186

Section 6 (3): “In adopting rules under this section,
the Environmental Quality Commission shall
evaluate:

- (c) Flexible implementation approaches to
minimize compliance costs”

Required by or recommended in HB 2186

1. Many ways to comply
2. Deferrals for adequate fuel supply
3. Consumer Cost Safety Net (price of gasoline and diesel)
4. Phase-in of compliance schedule

Not required by HB 2186

1. Opt-in parties
2. Transfer of regulated party status with sale of fuel (in some cases)
3. Credits, deficits and trading
 - a) Banking credits
 - b) Carry over of “small” deficit

Not required by HB 2186 (continued)

1. New Fuel Pathways
2. Exemptions for small volume fuel producers/threshold
3. Future review of rule
