

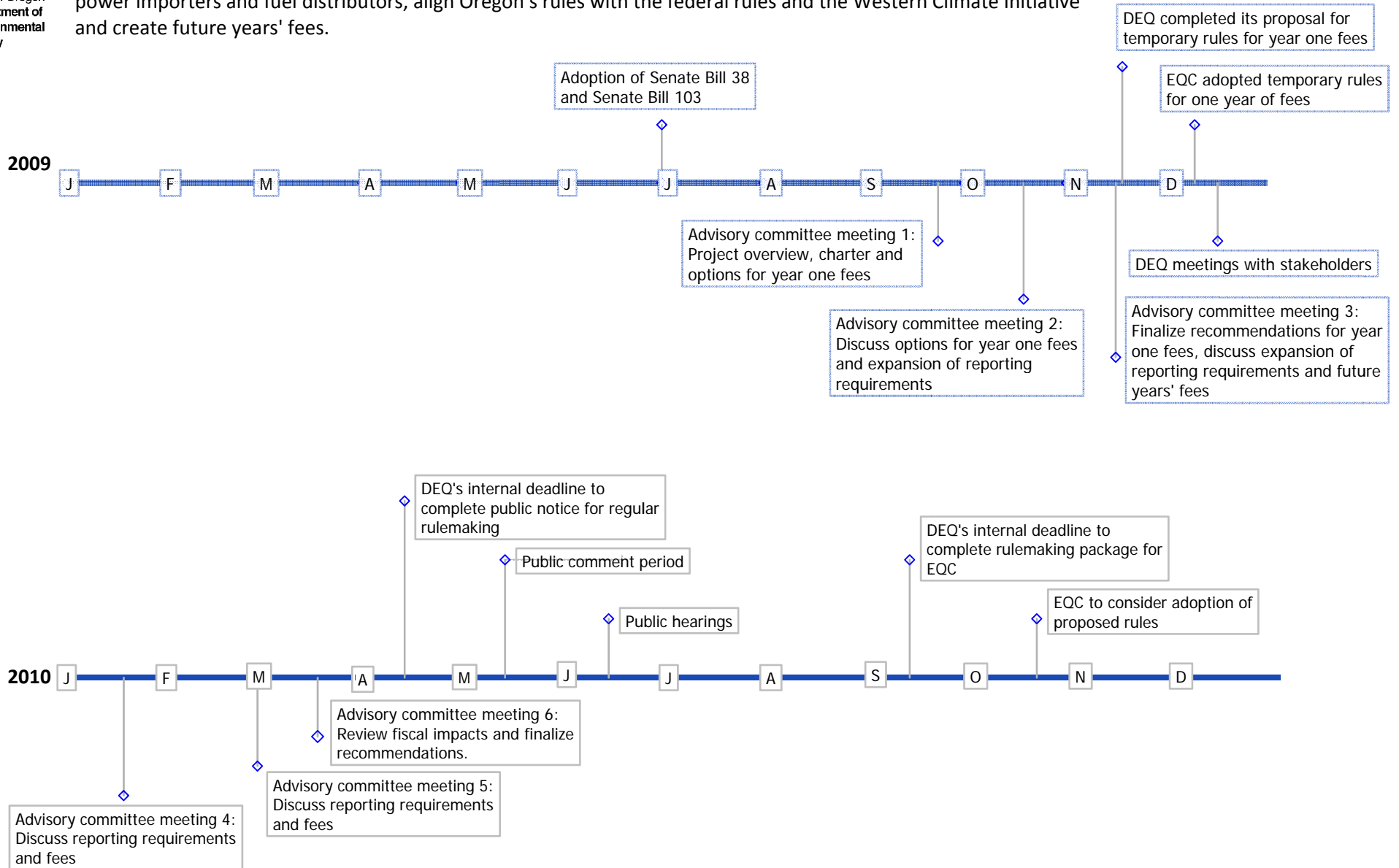

## Tentative timeline for updates to Oregon's greenhouse gas reporting program

### Key items:

- The greenhouse gas reporting advisory committee will hold meetings and provide recommendations about DEQ's draft rules.
- EQC adopted temporary rule amendments in December 2009 to create one year of fees
- DEQ will propose a follow-up regular rulemaking for adoption in mid-2010 to expand reporting requirements to power importers and fuel distributors, align Oregon's rules with the federal rules and the Western Climate Initiative and create future years' fees.
